Monthly Financial Report

End of June 2015 Financial Report:

Committee Updates

- Website: Carol will begin work as soon as possible. Three volunteers were previously recruited;
 need to check in on their current status
- Finance: discuss <u>promotional video</u> We need a storyboard and have a clear focus to get to that point; 1st video should be informative about our organization <= 2min. Look at the links in the documents and give feedback about the style preferences. Mark will put an outline together for what should end up in the clip.
- Disaster response: stand-by team; <u>Mission Coordinator</u> Mark likes the idea of having a calendar that those selected could indicate their availability.
 - Make the level of commitment clear. also, clarify that this is a volunteer position.
 - We need to make a decision about where the collaborative environment for the coordinators (Podio, Google, etc...). Make one of the coordinators in charge of this environment.
 - Language needs to be added that clarifies these are volunteer positions only.
 - Free training online for humanitarian/disaster. We could perhaps make this a requirement to make sure they are committed to supporting their roles. (Heather)
 - Duration of coordinators' commitment should be defined, for example they are recruited for 1 year.
 - This discussion to be continued through email.

- 1. Nepal project with ACAPS: Brian Baldwin from ESRI was recruited. He has already started work on the project, which ends August 28.
- GeoTag-X crowdsourcing project UNITAR: Shoreh: project is completed. Dave sent
 certificates and GISP letters. They have asked for a second project (in Yemen) and sent the
 JD last night. They are targeting the weekend of August 29th.
- 3. <u>TerraWatchers</u>: Shoreh/Dave: first phase is closed, waiting for a JD for the 2nd phase from the PA.
- 4. AAAS Syria: Shoreh: volunteer is in contact with the PA. It's going well.
