Ongoing projects (10):

- **Nigeria: GRDC's second recruitment**: Mark concluded that Hassan is no longer a volunteer for this project (no response from him). He will start a new recruitment.
- **UNO-PLUS mission:** Smitha is on maternity leave and they might ask for a new volunteer.
- Mission in Malawi: the mission is on hold.
- Mozambique Niassa National Reserve: the second phase is on hold.
- Mozambique Tourism Ministry: new imagery was donated by Digital Globe
- N. Korea: Project with iMMAP/WFP: a very impressive rate of progress especially from the new volunteers. Asked them to send in their profiles to create a special page for their project.
- Conscious Global Change Inc.: a new volunteer is joining the project.
- Wichita Refuge, OK (Fish and Wildlife): ongoing and progressing very well.
- American Red Cross: no update.
