 - Strategic Vision: In one or two brief paragraphs, describe what the vision for this work area will look like in 5 years. How do you see it functioning within URISA and what role will it play in the future of the profession?
 - "GISCorps has been designed as a means for GIS Professionals to give back to the community by providing GIS services/expertise to those in need who otherwise could not afford these services. We do not see that changing. Over the past few years we have added Crowdsourcing projects to our list of project types; this enables us to get more of our volunteers involved in missions. We do not envision the vision/mission of GISCorps changing although we do continually look at incorporating new technologies to assist us with the work we do. We are also keen to increase our funding and hire part time help to assist with many of the day-to-day activities of GISCorps administration. We are actively looking to recruit more qualified Core Committee members to help disperse the workload of current Core Committee members to allow for future growth.
 - We need a formal strategic plan and have a separate call about it.
 - Other thoughts on 5-year plan?
 - Volunteer base (skills, numbers, training?)
 - Projects (outreach, numbers, type)
 - Internal Structure (Board of Advisers, Exec Director, CC, Paid asst., Chapters, Subcommittees...?)
 - Funding (where is the money going to go?)
 - Technical (GDrive, website, vol database, AGO)
