- Annual Strategic Plan update was submitted.

Technical (Website/Vol database/GSuite

- GSuite migration Carol/Holly
 - Group exemption letter is no longer a possibility unless four URISA chapters also want to be included in the group exemption because the IRS has just approved new rules that allow group exemptions only for organizations with five or more subordinate organizations.
 - However, I applied for Google for Nonprofits using our TechSoup validation token (which I had set up for Slack), and we were deemed eligible for Google for Nonprofits. Once that happened, I was able to request for G Suite for Nonprofits, and that request is now under review. I should know the verdict on that within 3-4 days. I think the best case scenario is that they will say we need to upgrade to G Suite Basic first, and worst case scenario they will deny the request.

- 7-day usage
 - Down to 302,153 requests per day for the REST service
 - 4,092 views per day for the Testing Sites Locator app
- San Francisco Chronicle and New York Times are both working with our data
- Need to figure out whether to add new volunteers or to continue as is (and continue to encourage form submissions from testing providers).
