  - o 23 vols, 93 hours

  - o Interviews completed, volunteers chosen and webpost published.

  - o Working with URISA members in the ESJ working group. Hoping to begin volunteer search soon pending additional input from ESJ working group.
  - o Issues working in the URISA AGO organization have been resolved per Wendy.

  - o The volunteer is in touch with the PA. A survey is designed and will be sent to the stakeholders once the PA approves it. The project post was published last week.

  - o Field crew sent testing data for Roger to build the dashboard. Roger reached out for some technical advice and problem was resolved.

12. **PA Resources Council (289): Wincy**
- Project back on track and is going well.
13. **Warehouses4Good (285): Troy**
- No change from last month. Everything is going well.
14. **COVID-19 Lost Loved Ones and stories of Recovery (283) - Shoreh/Konrad**
- We have received ~25 submissions this month. Three volunteers have agreed to stay on board.
  - To date, 108 submissions have been validated by the volunteers.
  - Still only one submission to the stories of recoveries app.
15. **COVID-19 Testing Sites (282) - Holly/Erin/Troy**
- Small group of dedicated volunteers still contributing
  - Over 30,000 testing sites created so far
  - Continuing to emphasize the idea of getting health depts and testing providers to submit their own data to us
    - 1,619 new sites submitted by the public through our Survey123 form
    - 817 site updates have been submitted.
  - Still processing regular updates from HERE Technologies, Massachusetts Emergency Management Agency, and CVS.
  - 7-day usage is up, probably because of the surge in cases
    - Requests per day for the REST service have nearly doubled since last month to about 490,000.
    - About 3,798 views per day for the Testing Sites Locator app (about a 20% increase). Over 11 million views total.
    - Views of the COVID-19 Testing in the US dashboard is up by about 130% (275 views per day)

### Other business

- **The Protected Area Management Solution (PAM): Shoreh**
  - Asked Esri if the Learn Path is ready and if we can schedule the training with them soon. They said that they did not think Esri was supposed to train us and that we shouldn't wait for them to start the recruitment process. Sent them a couple of emails and went over the agreed upon steps (per the NGS agreement) and offered that we meet with them to further discuss. Waiting on their response.
    - Revise the JD to include expertise for developing the curriculum.
    - The curriculum would be based on Esri's generic material.
  - The grant was received this month.
