21. 283 - COVID-19 Lost Loved Ones and Stories of Recovery - Shoreh/Konrad

22. 282 - COVID-19 Testing Sites - Holly

- Project continues with increased usage and form submissions.
- Focusing on data cleanup at this point, with some new QA/QC tools added to the volunteer portal
- Still receiving regular bulk updates from CVS and volunteers.
- Over 42,000 testing sites and 36,000 vaccination sites mapped
- 7-day usage:
 - Requests for the REST services are up to about 187,000 per day, more than twice last month. Over 16 million views total.

- o Daily views of the locator apps are up a little to just over 1,800 views a day.
